#### **HYNEK CLASSIFICATION**

CE1	[ ]	Description: UFOs are visually observed at a close range, typically within 500 feet, showcasing considerable detail and size.
CE2	[]	Description: Events involves a physical effect, such as interference with electronics, animal reactions, physical discomfort in observers, or tangible traces like ground impressions or scorched vegetation.
CE3	[]	Description: Involves sightings of animate entities, such as humanoids or robots, often perceived as pilots or occupants of the UFO.
CE4	[ ]	<b>Description</b> : Encounter involves human abduction by UFOs or their occupants.
CE5	[ ]	Description: Deliberate human-initiated communication with extraterrestrial or advanced interstellar entities.

The "SP-23 Close Encounter Type Expansion Classification" scale augments the traditional CE1 through CE-5 Hynek classifications by introducing additional categories that reflect contemporary understandings and experiences with UFO/UAP phenomena.

This scale seeks to encompass a wider range of encounters, including those that involve more subtle or complex interactions between humans and unidentified aerial phenomena.

CE6, Direct Communication	[]	Description: CE6 cases involve witnesses reporting direct communication with entities connected to the UFO/UAP. This communication can manifest through telepathy, electronic devices, or other means, with an emphasis on non-verbal interaction, often involving the transmission of intricate ideas or emotions.
		Characteristics: Communication in CE6 cases is typically non-verbal and may encompass the exchange of complex thoughts or emotions.
CE7, Biological Effects	[]	Description: Incidents where there is direct physical interaction between the UFO/UAP and a witness, leading to biological effects such as unexplained injuries, physiological changes, or healing phenomena.
		Characteristics: Effects can be immediate or manifest over time; may include physical markings, altered health states, or psychological transformations.

CE8, Transdimensional Interaction	[]	Description: Experiences suggesting interaction with entities or craft that appear to operate beyond conventional three-dimensional space and time, indicating possible transdimensional capabilities.
		Characteristics: Includes sightings of entities or objects appearing/disappearing suddenly, altering physical reality, or affecting the perception of time.
CE9, Environmental Manipulation	[]	Description: Cases where UFO/UAP presence leads to significant, often unexplained, environmental changes or anomalies, like alterations in weather, wildlife behavior, or landscape.
		Characteristics: Changes are localized and closely tied to the timing and location of the UFO/UAP sighting.
CE10, Collective Experience	[]	<b>Description</b> : Events where groups of people simultaneously witness a UFO/UAP and experience a shared reality alteration or a collective psychological impact.
		Characteristics: Often involves large groups and can include shared visions, altered states of consciousness, or simultaneous recollection of similar experiences.
CE11, Technological Interaction	[ ]	Description: Incidents that involve direct interaction between UFO/UAP and human-made technology, leading to significant and unexplained technological phenomena.
		Characteristics: Can include interference with electronic devices, unexplained technological failures, or advanced technological insights post-encounter.
